BY-LAW NO. 221

BY-LAW ESTABLISHING THE REMUNERATION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCILLORS

WHEREAS the municipal council adopted By-law No. 212 on April 9th, 2018 modifying by-laws No. 86, 125, 135, 143, 164 and 191 establishing the remuneration of the mayor and councillors;

WHEREAS the municipal council has judged it necessary to replace the aforementioned By-law;

WHEREAS for the year 2019, the annual remuneration for council is \$34,763.08 for the Mayor and \$11,588.04 for councillors;

WHEREAS it is appropriate that these amounts be indexed for the following year;

It is proposed by Councillor Thomas Lavallee

And unanimously resolved

THAT a By-law bearing the No. 221 be adopted and decreed as follows:

ARTICLE 1 PREFACE

The preface is part of the present By-law.

ARTICLE 2 TITLE

The present By-law will have the following title *By-law No. 221 establishing the remuneration of the mayor and councillors.*

ARTICLE 3 PURPOSE

The purpose of the present By-law is to determine the remuneration of council members for the year 2019 and the following years.

ARTICLE 4 REMUNERATION

The basic salary for the position of Mayor for the year 2019 is \$34,763.08. The basic salary for the position of Councillor for the year 2019 is \$11,588.04.

Remuneration of the pro-Mayor:

The pro-Mayor will receive an additional remuneration in the amount of \$ 1,000 to the amount received as a member of Council.

ARTICLE 5 INDEXATION

The remunerations as established in article 4 will be indexed for each fiscal year starting in 2020. The indexation rate will be equal to the rising Quebec region consumer cost of living rate established by Statistics Canada on the 31st day of October of the fiscal year preceding the year to which the indexation applies, plus 1%;

ARTICLE 6 ALLOCATION OF TAXABLE EXPENSES TO A LEVEL OF GOVERNMENT

For the year in which the expense allowance becomes taxable at one of the levels of government, in addition to the indexation provided for in article 5 of this Regulation, the basic remuneration of the Mayor and Councillors is increased by 23% of the amount equivalent to the amount of the expense allowance to which they are entitled.

ARTICLE 7 ALLOCATION OF TAXABLE EXPENSES TO TWO LEVEL OF GOVERNMENTS

For the year which the expense becomes taxable at the two level of governments, in addition to the indexation provided for in article 5 of the present Regulation, the remuneration of the Mayors and Councillors is increases by 45% of the amount equivalent to the amount of the expenses allowance to which they are entitled for the taxation year, less any increase made under article 6 of this Regulation, as the case may be.

ARTICLE 8 REPLACEMENT

By-law No. 212 modifying By-laws No. 86, 125, 135, 143, 164 and 191 establishing the remuneration of the mayor and councillors is replaced by the present By-law.

ARTICLE 9 RETROACTIVITY

The present By-law is retroactive to January 1st, 2019.

ARTICLE 10 COMING INTO FORCE

The present By-law No. 221 will come into force in conformity with the law.
