HARMONIZED REGULATIONS ON PUBLIC SAFETY AND THE PROTECTION OF PERSONS AND PROPERTY

-For uniform interventions on the territory

Saint-Gabriel-de-Valcartier, June 13, 2019 – A new harmonized By-law on the public safety of persons and property will be applicable in Saint-Gabriel-de-Valcartier, as of June 3, 2019.

This By-law states the municipal regulations across the territory of the MRC, notably in matters of security, peace and order, nuisances, insalubrity, traffic, animals, alarm systems, peddling, drinking water, signage and parking.

An initiative of the Sûreté du Québec

On the MRC de La Jacques-Cartier territory, as well as in Saint-Gabriel-de-Valcartier, the Sûreté du Québec (SQ) is mandated to insure the maintenance of peace and public order, the preservation of life and the security of citizens. For some years now, the SQ has had to work with different regulations for each of the nine cities and municipalities. This is how, in collaboration with the MRC de La Jacques-Cartier and the municipalities, the by-laws from the nine cities and municipalities pertaining to public security and the protection of property have been harmonized.

“Harmonizing our regulations on public security with the other cities and municipalities of the MRC will facilitate the interventions and the work of peace officers and municipal officers” commented the Mayor of Saint-Gabriel-de-Valcartier, Mr. Brent Montgomery.
