10.1 Report from the person responsible for Public Works – Mr. Dany Laberge

Mr. Dany Laberge gives a verbal report of the Public Works Department's activities. Here is a summary:

Removal and replacement of a section of wooden decking on Clark's Bridge:

In September 2019, the contract for the removal and replacement of a section of the wooden decking of Clark's bridge was awarded to the company Les Dalles Parko with option 1 for night work for 8 nights. Construction was delayed in the spring of 2020 due to the early arrival of winter. The scheduled date for the work was set for the first week of May. The start date is postponed due to the closure of construction sites until April 13 due to COVID-19 / Coronavirus.

10.2 Awarding of contract for the maintenance of street lights
