Quebec Ministry of Transport:

In a correspondence dated April 9th, 2020, the Ministry of Transport informed the Municipality that it has received and read resolution No 030320 concerning the extension of the school zone in front of Valcartier Elementary School. The steps necessary for carrying out a study are underway. However, the current pandemic situation could cause certain delays. The Ministry hopes to be able to supply to results of the analysis during the 2020 summer. Signs reading "Yield to pedestrians" have been installed at the pedestrian crossing during the last few weeks by the MTQ.

Fire Safety Services activities during the COVID-19 pandemic:

10.1 Report from the person responsible for Public Works – Mr. Dany Laberge

Mr. Dany Laberge gives a verbal report of the Public Works Department's activities. Here is a summary:

Removal and replacement of a section of wooden decking on Clark's Bridge:

In September 2019, the contract for the removal and replacement of a section of the wooden decking of Clark's bridge was awarded to the company Les Dalles Parko with option 1 for night work for 8 nights. Construction was delayed in the spring of 2020 due to the early arrival of winter. The scheduled date for the work has been set to May 11th, 2020.

HHW collection:

The HHW collection will be held on May 30th, 2020 in the parking lot of the municipal garage.

11.2 Report from the Municipal Inspector

Mr. Stacy Gagné gives a verbal report of the Ubanism Department activities.

Construction of cottages and/or yurts on the same property:

WHEREAS the Municipality of Saint-Gabriel-de-Valcartier has received two requests from two separate citizens asking to build several small cottages and/or yurts in order to exploit as short-term rentals of the Airbnb type;

WHEREAS one of the projects consists in installing a communal parking lot from where renters could access on foot a cottage or a yurt equipped with basic commodities such as electricity, a small cooktop, etc. These renters would share, with other renters, the same sanitary facilities;

WHEREAS both requests are for approximately 2 to 5 cottages/yurts on the same property.

11.3 Control of biting insects on the territory of the Valcartier Military Base

WHEREAS the biological treatment for the control of biting insects began on May 4th, 2020 on the territory of the Municipality;

WHEREAS the Valcartier Military Base territory was not part of the initial call for bids;

WHEREAS to maximise treatments, it is timely to treat a part of the Valcartier Military Base territory;

WHEREAS Conseillers Forestiers Roy have received the authorization from Valcartier Military Base authorities to carry out treatments on a part of their territory, notably in proximity to the Valcartier Community Centre sports and recreation installations;

WHEREAS the authorization granted by the military base allows three continuous treatments within a three-week interval during the months of May and June;

WHEREAS palliate the treatments for the months of July and August, six carbonic dioxide traps will be installed along the limits of the military base on the public land of the Municipality.

AND RESOLVED BY MAJORITY:

To accept Conseillers Forestiers Roy' offer of services for the control of biting insects on the territory of the Valcartier military base in the amount of \$19,500 plus applicable taxes.

Councillor Maureen Bédard opposes this treatment, she is in favor of letting nature take its course.

12. RECREATION, CULTURE AND COMMUNITY LIFE

12.1 Report from the Sports and Recreation Director – Mrs. Pamala Laberge

Summer day camp:

According to the Government guidelines, summer day camps in Quebec are part of the deconfinement measures. Preparation for the summer Playground program have begun. We are currently recruiting animators. The registration period will begin soon.

Other activities:

The municipal library, Club Ados and the Physik Centre remain closed until further notice. The possibility of offering soccer and softball this summer are under study once again, according to Public health officials.

Community Life:

Older and more vulnerable people in our community continue to be contacted on a regular basis.

Community Yard Sale:

This activity has been cancelled due to COVID-19.

13. MRC AND REGIONAL DOSSIERS

The Mayor, Brent Montgomery informed the members of Council that the last session of the MRC Council of Mayors was held on April 15th, 2020 by telephone conference.

The next sitting will be held on May 20th, 2020 at 7:00 pm.

Financial Aid Program for small and medium businesses:

This program aims to support the working capital of companies whose financial situation is precarious due to COVID-19. The envelope for the MRC de La Jacques-Cartier is \$ 601,908. This fund is administered by the *Société de développement économique de la Jacques-Cartier*.

Sale for non-payment of taxes:

The MRC de la Jacques-Cartier has suspended the suspended the process of selling properties for non-payment of taxes on March 30, 2020 given the impossibility of proceeding due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Order 2020-014 of April 2nd, 2020 from the Minister of Health and Social Services specifies that any property sales at public auction for failure to pay municipal or school taxes must be postponed until the end of the state of health emergency. Consequently, a By-Law was adopted to postpone the sale to the second Thursday of October 2020. The Municipality of Saint-Gabriel-de-Valcartier had not submitted a file for this year.
